

MILK CARTON BIRD FEEDER





Cut out a pentagon shaped opening with a craft knife. Adults should help children with this part.



Insert this roof
piece into the top of
the pentagon shaped
opening. Press the
flaps with your fingers against the
inside of the milk
carton until the
double-sided tape
holds tightly and you
have a roof!



Using the piece you cut out of the milk carton. Fold in half along its length. Cut a half-inch from the point of the peak down the center fold. Fold up a half-inch flap on either side of this cut. Apply double stick tape to these flaps.

Poke a bamboo skewer or twig through of the milk carton, just below the left side of the opening. Do the same on the right side of the opening. Make sure the skewers or sticks poke out the back wall of the carton to keep the perches secure.





Put twine through two poked holes in the top. Fill the bottom of the feeder with a small bird seed. Hang your milk carton bird feeder from a tree branch.
